In association with Tata Steel Management Development Centre, designed a webinar series on different topics.


1.1 STIMULUS Session 1: Social Styles


1.2 STIMULUS Session 2: Reading & Understanding Financial Statements

2.1 BAKE Session 1: Stress Management During Lock Down






2.2 BAKE Session 2: Marketing & Branding

Prof. Amitava Bandhopadhyay is a senior faculty at Indian Statistical Institute, Kolkata. Analytics today is equated to magic. We expect accurate predictions - whatever be the circumstances. 
ACTIVITIES IN MAY 2020

2.4 ELS Session 4: Financial planning & Investment Ideas in stock Market





4.1 EDGE 1: Python for Data Science




5. Brain Bytes Quiz Competition

2.5 ELS Session 5: "Every Breath Matters" An Hour for Lung Care






4.3 EDGE Session 3: Introduction to Artificial Intelligence & the changing job market



Jamshedpur Management Association celebrated women's day with two day online program.


The theme of this year's International women's day was #ChoosetoChallenge. On




4.4 JMA EDGE Session 4: World Water Day Celebration

25. JMA Campus to Corporate online workshop




